New Dress Code

The following dress code is in place for the 2006-2007 school year:

- 6th grade - white shirts
- 7th grade - light blue shirts
- 8th grade - navy blue shirts
(Shirts should be 3-button polo style shirts.)
- School t-shirts with Wolverine logos will only be worn on Fridays - Spirit Day.
- Navy blue or khaki bottoms as part of the uniform remains the same, but students **will not be allowed to wear shorts, skorts, capris, nor crop pants**. Only long pants or skirts (middle finger tip length) will be allowed.
- For safety reasons, it was voted that students would only be allowed to wear plain belt buckles and those with name plates or scrolling messages.
- No hooded clothing (sweatshirts, sweaters, sweatpants, shirts) will be allowed.

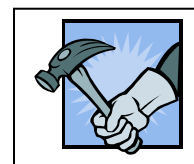
Hooded Sweaters, Jackets & Sweatshirts
